## FROM DAVE'S DESK

Hello everyone!

Summer is a time of weddings, anniversaries, open houses, camp, camping and, of course, vacations. We have several youth taking part in the busy summer schedule at Elkhorn Valley. Jerry Coxson and I will join Tim and Jeania Bebech for Creative Arts week at Elkhorn beginning this July 5th. Do pray for our children and adults who venture back and forth to Elkhorn Valley.

Because summer is so busy it is extremely difficult to get people together to attend meetings. The last two **all**-ministry leaders meetings were poorly attended. Our next scheduled all-ministry group leaders meeting is Sunday, July 26th at 6:00 pm. If you are a ministry group leader, please try to attend this meeting. If you are out of town, please specifically ask someone from your team to represent you at the meeting other than one of our elders. Due to the fact that so many activities happen on our church calendar from August –October, the July meeting is perhaps the key gathering for pivotal planning throughout the year.

Mostly, I want to challenge everyone to be regular in worship services this summer. We will continue our 10:30 am service with Reflection groups to follow right through the summer and into the fall season. Reflection is on a one year trial run with options to tweak as we (Elders and Education ministry) deem necessary.

On Sunday, June 14th we embarked on a new sermon series – a practical study of the book of Revelation (*note schedule on page 4*). Here are just a few things to ponder about why I should study this amazing book.

### **Why should I study the book of Revelation?**

Is it really relevant to my life?

First, God's inerrant Word is a reliable map. No matter how difficult it is to comprehend the mind-blowing visions presented in Revelation, we must not forget that it is part of God's Word. As such, it includes an inherent blessing from simply reading, hearing, and keeping those things we do understand. If we comprehend at least the big picture of the book and its truth, we need not be disturbed or confused by the details. Second, God's sovereign plan replaces fear with hope. People all over the world live under superstition, fear of the unknown, apprehension about the future, and an overwhelming feeling that the whole world is out of control. Wars, famines, diseases, natural disasters—all of these tragedies appear to be evidence that chaos reigns. However, the Revelation shows that God is working out His sovereign plan, that evil will one day be destroyed, and that in the end, God wins! Knowledge of this fundamental truth replaces fear with hope and confidence. Third, God's glorious Son is worthy of worship. As humans, we choose to trust in many things and place confidence in various people. Revelation tells us that only one Man is worthy to be the object of our complete, undivided faith—the Son of God incarnate, Jesus Christ. He is the center of our worship, the focus of our obedience, and the source of our blessing, both now and in the future. Fourth, Revelation is a practical book for the church and for Christians who are seeking to be like Jesus in every way. Jesus shows up on every page of this letter and every time I read it my life is changed and my outlook is more heaven-focused. Please take time to read the book of Revelation in anticipation as we continue this series.

## EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT

The Elders of Corner House are together convinced of a need to hire a part-time Executive Assistant for the church office. We have been blessed to have Mabel Bancroft, Kata Gainard, Carm Shockey, Avis Matthews, Joyce Dripps, and a few others filling roles and meeting needs in the office and at home the past two years. Although everyone plays a specific role, it has become evident that the overall task of office administration is still daunting. We need the continual presence of someone in the office, administrating, greeting guests, handling phone calls and assisting the Minister with day to day tasks. Our current volunteers do a great job taking care of membership, record keeping, bulletins, typing and posting meeting minutes, newsletters, ordering supplies, power point and attendance. They have agreed to continue to provide as many of these services as necessary on a volunteer basis in order to enable our Executive Assistant to fulfill the need to assist in sustaining and growing our church. The elders have determined it is in the best interest of our congregation to hire someone from outside our church body. We are currently working with a local Temp Agency to fill this position. Our needs have been assessed by this agency and they hope to have someone available to give it a go by the middle of July. Any questions about the position of Executive Assistant and our timing in making this appointment should be addressed to the Corner House elders.

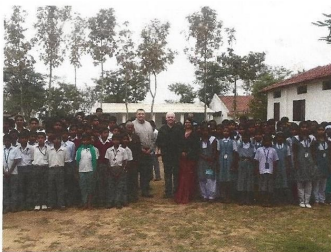
